The electric doors open automatically pushing the cart to the car during our short stay in Vermont to write our doctoral thesis and have a bit of rest, I have gone to the local grocery store. So many food choices at my finger tips....kiwi fruit from New Zealand, cherries from Brazil, corn on the cob from Georgia. My nose crinkles with frustration and I bite the upper corner of my lip, reminded of the email Todd received hours earlier. The church in Betaola is closed and members fled their village due to famine. Two years ago the locust ate the crops. This year there was no rain. The result? Hunger, malnutrition, famine, starvation. Our prayer is that this is a temporary issue, solvable by getting an engineer to come and evaluate the situation to determine how to tap into the local spring or build a well to pump water for their crops. Churches have purchased rice and we are very thankful for their donations. The question still remains: Is there something we can do to prevent this famine from happening again in another few years? ~ Rev. Patricia McGregor
