Famine in Southern Madagascar

In my parents' diocese, the famine in Madagascar continues to be a problem. A three-year drought affecting over 1.3 million people, specifically in the southern area of the Diocese of Toliara, has persistently resulted in no harvest. People are dying and rice prices have doubled but even in tragedy hope remains. The Diocese of Toliara has partnered with USPG, the International Mothers' Union, and individual donors to distribute rice and beans to over 4,000 people. Furthermore, 167 women and their children at high-risk of malnutrition have found hope through an additional distribution of nutritional supplements. The women were not only grateful for the generosity of tangible food but were equally touched that someone cared. The power of the gospel continues to move in spite of this heart-breaking reality. Rain has come. However, in some of the most desperate areas, it is still lacking while in others extreme flooding has resulted. There is still much needed for famine interventions. Our hope is that people will come alongside the Malagasy community in prayer and support to fulfill their responsibility in show-ing God's children that we are people reaching people and someone still cares.

In Madagascar, only 2/3 of children are enrolled in primary school and only about 1/3 in secondary school. In the Diocese of Toliara, where PRP is actively assisting with education, these figures are even lower than the national average. Education, in other words, is not a given. Motivated by this reality, PRP is working to establish a child sponsorship program.

Moving to Madagascar to direct this program along with training in the Women's Center is a new missionary, Jackie Lowe. Jackie's career has been in teaching and she feels called to shift her work from her classroom in the US to the

mission field in Southern Madagascar. She is motivated and excited, knowing firsthand the potential of education to change lives.

The Synod meets every three years and this year marked stepping stones for transformation in the local communities. The four days of the Synod were spent in prayer, studying God's word, fellowship, and approving strategies. Those attending were very excited about the newly approved decisions and are eager for its future implications. The following strategies have been approved by the Diocese of Toliara:

- 1. Women's ordination
- 2. New Liturgy (Morning Prayer and Holy Communion)
- 3. Appointing an assistant bishop in the diocese, hopefully beginning in 2018
- 4. Miaraka Community

Everyone is enthusiastic about these new developments and feel encouraged by what God has done through the last three years. We are eager to see what He has in store for the next three years.
