Christmas in Madagascar is not the typical Christmas scene we think of with dashing through the snow and cozying up by the fire to open presents under the big pine tree. But never the less, it is filled with the love, joy, and giving spirit of Christmas. This year was no different. Despite being the ninth poorest country in the world, the Malagasy never allow finances to stop them from celebrating the birth of their Savior. The local parishioners hand crafted nativity scenes and ornaments to decorate the churches. The choir members met often to learn the carols newly translated into the local language. The Sunday School performed their yearly recital on Christmas Eve. The Mother's Union spent hours packaging sweets (instead of gifts) to distribute to the children. And on Christmas day, after all the official events were finished, the youth group stayed up all night in the church blaring the music, dancing and worshiping the birth of their Savior. Christmas in Madagascar is utterly remarkable. Without the craziness of commercialism, the simplicity of the real Christmas story is able to be truly appreciated. And that's what Christmas is all about.

CHANGING THE LIVES OF THE FUTURE GENERATION - MAHABOBOKA SCHOOL

Mahaboboka school, is a primary school in rural southern Madagascar, that was built from the financial support of Trinity Church Potsdam in New York, USA. On Jan 6, teachers, students, parents, evangelists, and clergy gathered to celebrate the end of a school term. After prayer time, introductions, and songs from each class, the Headmistress, Madame Louise, handed out grades and booklets to the students. 103 students ranging from 3 years old to 13 years old are currently enrolled in Mahaboboka school. Unfortunately, several of the students and their families were unable to attend the festivities since they live on the other side of the river and could not cross the river due to rains and high water. It was a precious moment to see the children, especially the little ones, walk to their teachers and receive their grades. Even at such a young age you could see how gratified they are to be in school. Trinity Church parishioners from New York, had sent gifts to the students for Christmas. After all the class songs and receiving their grades, the students individually came forward to receive the hand written cards and gifts from Trinity Church. The girls' faces just glowed when they were handed a doll or a cooking set. Similarly, the boys' faces were filled with smiles as they received a toy car and a small soccer ball. It is a moment they will all remember for the rest of their lives. Thank you again Trinity Church Potsdam for changing the lives of the future generation!

Highlights of the meeting included: commissioning a new student evangelist (named Evon), meetings of all the departments (Evangelism, Education, Finance, Partnership, Economic Development, Buildings and Grounds), adding mobile communication for the clergy, and a special presentation by new CMS missionaries Rev. Derek and Jane Waller.
