SHORT-TERM TEAMS PREPARE FOR 2009-2010 MISSION TRIPS

TEAMS FROM THE USA ARE MAKING PLANS FOR TRAVEL TO MADAGASCAR TO SPREAD THE GOSPEL TO THE POOREST OF THE POOR. THE NEXT TEAM SCHEDULED IS FROM BOCA RATON CHRISTIAN SCHOOL LED BY AMY BARNHILL. AMY IS A STUDENT WHO WAS SO IMPACTED FROM GOING TO KENYA TWO YEARS AGO THAT SHE IS NOW HEADING A TEAM. THEY ARE TRAVELING NOV. 20TH THROUGH DEC. 3RD, FOCUSING ON BIBLE STUDY, TEACHING ENGLISH AND EVANGELISM.

FROM MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE, A TEAM BY DOWNLINE MINISTRIES WILL MAKE THEIR SECOND MISSION TRIP TO TOLIARA, TENTATIVELY SCHEDULED FOR MARCH 2009. THIS FOLLOW-UP TRIP WILL FOCUS ON TRAINING PASTORS AND EVANGELISTS FOR THE ENTIRE COUNTRY OF MADAGASCAR IN THE BIBLICAL STANDARD OF DISCIPLESHIP. MCGREGORS TO PARTNER WITH SAMS-USA ~ By Laura Verinder

TODD AND PATSY ARE EXCITED ABOUT ANNOUNCING A NEW PARTNERSHIP IN THEIR MINISTRY. AFTER EXTENSIVE DISCUSSIONS, THE MCGREGORS HAVE ESTABLISHED A PARTNERSHIP WITH SAMS-USA (WWW.SAMSUSA.ORG) AS A MISSIONARY SENDING AGENCY. SAMS (SOUTH AMERICAN MISSION SOCIETY) IS ONE OF THE OLDEST ANGLICAN/EPISCOPAL MISSION AGENCIES HAVING WORKED WITH MISSIONARIES FOR OVER 150 YEARS. SAMS IS PLEASED TO WORK WITH THE MCGREGORS AS THEIR ESTABLISHED MISSION ACTIVITIES IN MADAGASCAR AND EAST AFRICA HELP SPREAD SAMS' OUTREACH EFFORTS.

WITH THE TERMINATION OF THE FORMAL MISSIONARY RELATIONSHIP WITH THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH, TODD AND PATSY WERE FACING SOME SIGNIFICANT ADMINISTRATIVE CHALLENGES INCLUDING ADMINISTRATION OF THEIR SALARY/ TAX LIABILITY, HEALTH AND LIFE INSURANCE AND PENSION PROGRAM. SAMS IS ABLE TO OFFER THIS ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT AS WELL AS SEVERAL ADDITIONAL BENEFITS. THROUGH SAMS, THE MCGREGORS WILL BE ABLE TO OFFER THEIR DONORS THE EASE OF PAYMENT BY CREDIT CARD AND AUTOMATIC MONTHLY DONATIONS. INCREASED VISIBILITY THROUGH THE SAMS WEB SITE AND OTHER SAMS MARKETING WILL HELP SPREAD THE WORD OF THE MINISTRY AND WILL OFFER A NEW SOURCE OF SHORT TERM MISSION TEAM SUPPORT.

THIS CHANGE DOES INCREASE THE FINANCIAL BURDEN ON THE MCGREGORS. THE COST OF HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUMS, PENSION AND TAX LIABILITY PREVIOUSLY FUNDED BY THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH WILL NOW NEED TO BE RAISED AS PART OF THE MINISTRY FUNDRAISING. SAMS CHARGES A COMPETITIVE PERCENTAGE TO COVER ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS. THE PEOPLE REACHING PEOPLE BOARD DID A CAREFUL COMPARISON OF SENDING AGENCIES AND SAMS OFFERED THE BEST VALUE WITH INCREASED BENEFITS OF ALL OPTIONS EXAMINED.

DONATION COLLECTION WILL TRANSITION FROM THE DIOCESE OF SOUTHEAST FLORIDA TO SAMS IN MARCH 2009. THE MCGREGORS (AND THE ENTIRE PRP BOARD) THANK THE DIOCESE OF SOUTHEAST FLORIDA FOR THEIR CONTINUING SUPPORT OF THIS MINISTRY.
