DAYS FOR GIRLS TRAINING

Days for Girls is an international non-profit focusing on creating a more dignified, free, and educated world through increasing access of feminine hygiene products. Unfortunately, women all over the world miss school, are stigmatized, and live with economic barriers due to menses. Madagascar is no different! Frequently girls miss school because they have no hygiene products to use. In some places, women are forbidden to receive communion when mensing. Others are required to wear ribbons to symbolize their uncleanliness. Therefore to counteract these problems, Days for Girls offers affordable and sustainable female hygiene kits. The Diocese of Toliara has held multiple Days for Girls trainings. We are proud to announce that Ms. Harisoa has been appointed as the Days For Girls Assistant Coordinator at the Women's Center. She has done a great job teaching the trainings. She even demonstrated the ease of running and dancing while wearing the product. We are excited to see how this partnership grows.

Unlike how many Americans think of rain as a nuisance, in Madagascar, rain is a blessing. Rain is God's way of showing how He still takes cares for our most basic needs. Rain is what allows the plants to grow and the flowers to blossom.

So there I was standing at the pulpit infront of 350 people giving the sermon for the official welcoming of Bishop Samitiana. My sermon started out with a story of two men who started praying together daily in 1991. These two men were Bishop Todd and Bishop Samitiana. Even before we knew it, God was creating their relationship. And this relationship created a Diocese founded in prayer. I then proceeded to show the congregation the documented Prayers in Color for specific churches and parishioners.

It was an amazing service. You could feel the Holy Spirit blessing the Diocese. You could feel God looking down on his humble servants, Bishop Samitiana and his family, and sense His satisfaction. You could feel the encouragement from the congregation that prayer really does create miracles. Rain, God's symbol of blessing and contentment was exactly what we need. God, thank you for the rain!

SHORT TERM MISSIONS WITH SIMON & SUE BABBS

This summer, Simon and Sue Babbs, from St. James the Less Episcopal Church in Illinois, took their 4th mission trip to Madagascar. Sue focused on Days for Girls training and distribution, while Simon taught bookkeeping and lead philosophy discussions. It was an exciting time to see God work through their visit.

In 2016, Sue created of the Days for Girls Program in Madagascar. This year's trip allowed her to reinforce the already established program through hygiene training and product distribution. Female health lessons were translated into Malagasy. 35 women were trained to teach hygiene to the local community and explain the benefits of the washable feminine hygiene kits. Over 900 women and girls were educated on personal hygiene. 437 female hygiene kits were distributed in churches, villages, medical clinics and one school.

Simon spent his days working with the diocesan accountant on bookkeeping. He also lead two philosophy sessions for the clergy. The first session focused on the relationship between faith and reason and the role philosophy can play in thinking about Christian doctrine. The second session was a discussion of seven different understandings of the Eucharist. Despite the conversations occurring in a combination of languages (Malagasy, French and English), they were filled with contemplative and thought provoking ideas.

He spoke to the clergy, evangelists, synod committee, and Mother's Union. The program focuses on Bible studies and memorization of God's word to transform a person's life. In the near future. Rev. Derek will train all the parishes in the program. The goal of the Diocese is that every church will have Rooted in Jesus by 2020.

DIOCESE IS GROWING

We thank God that He continues to work and the Diocese of Toliara continues to grow abundantly. One of the biggest challenges for the Diocese is the shortage of clergy. With 87 churches, there are only 6 parish priests. As growth continues, the need for leadership is abundant. There are currently 4 vacant parish priest positions. Please pray for strong Godfearing leaders to fill those positions.

STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

We want to specifically thank those who have supported the student scholarship program. Evangelist Gaston, one of the scholars, is starting his final year studying for a Bachelors of Theology at the Roman Catholic University.
