TRAVELS WITH BISHOP TODD

Recently I (Todd) went to Andranovory for confirmations among the Antandroy ethnic group. For the last four years I had been traveling here for confirmations. However, this trip was different. This time there had been significant spiritual growth and as a result I was confirming 84 candidates. One of the stories that sticks out during my visit was from a man named Fagnintona. He came from a village 15-20 kilometers away. He told of the story about him coming to faith as a result of the Anglican mission coming to his village. He was so excited to hear about Christ that he repented and accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior. He then got the village people to follow his new found faith and they built a temporary church. He also traveled to his native ancestral home about 15 kilometers from where he lives now. While there he was served coffee and food but before he ate he stopped and prayed. His relatives were so astonished by this, that they asked him what he was doing? He informed them that he was thanking God through Jesus Christ for his meal. They asked him more about Christianity and finally agreed to accept this new found faith as well. He then motivated them to construct three new churches in his ancestral land. I had the privilege to visit most of these churches and I'm truly impressed with these new converts. It is people like Fagnintona, a born evangelist, who makes a difference in the kingdom of God through sharing new born faith with others. His life transformation was apparent because all he wanted to do was talk about Jesus.

"We have prayers in English every Friday at 11:30. Would you like to come?" I repeated it in Malagasy in case he did not understand but he responded again in English.

"Yes, on Friday. I will come. 11:30."

And guess who showed up for service the next Friday at 11:30. Noeldo. And he even brought a friend!
